# A Quick Overview

The management of electronic health records (EHR) and clinical documents is becoming important in the workflow of healthcare providers. Although healthcare professionals working in different departments can access to patients' information from as many different systems as possible, there is no one centralized and secure system that manages multiple system information in one place. Some Healthcare Information Systems (HIS) follow standards in designing system structure and communications protocols, but many do not. In fact, some of them are proprietary and can't be integrated with others.

SolidACS (Document Archiving and Communication System) is the innovation from EBM Technologies to fulfill the need of an all-in-one storage for clinical documents. To achieve interoperability, SolidACS is capable to archive all clinical evidences and medical images for daily medical care, clinical research, lawsuit corroboration and hospital management.

The comprehensive document managing solution links other systems in a hospital and shows list of all documents of a patient sorted by either date or document types. SolidACS also allows user to compare two documents

(e.g. different versions, studies and types of documents) in one view.

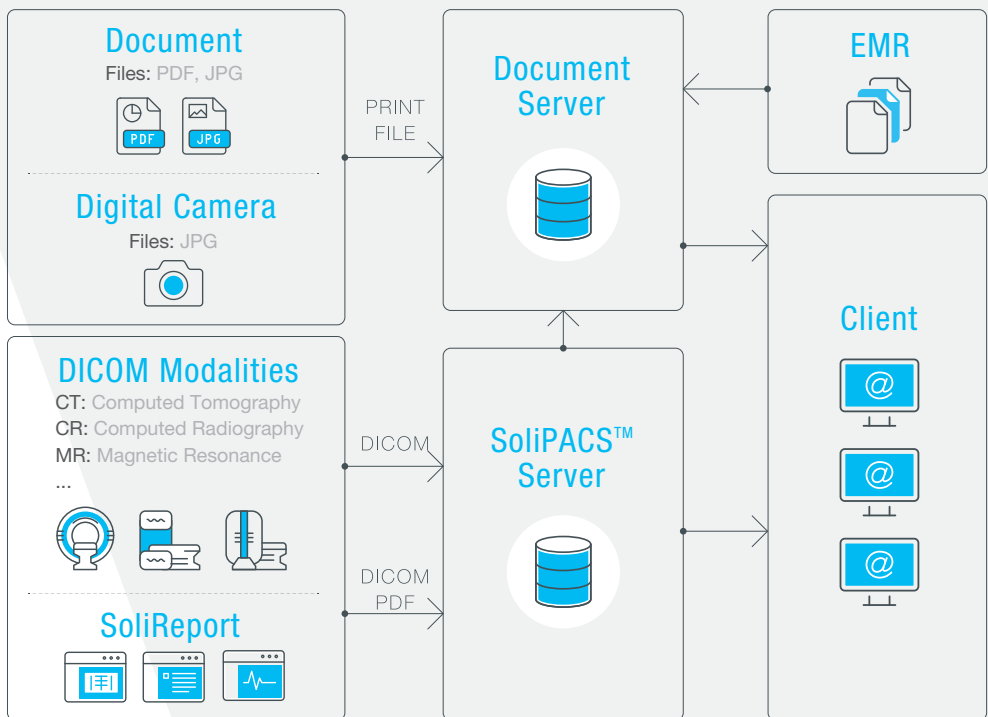
As SolidACS is becoming recognized in the market, it will serve as an important data backup solution for all department systems while eliminating the paper documents from hospitals.
